



## Larry "Butch" Michael Boydston

February 7, 1948 - March 16, 2022

Larry "Butch" Michael Boydston, passed away on March 16, 2022, at his home in Lindsay, Oklahoma, at the age of 74. He was born to Cecil "Buck" Marlin Boydston and Rosa Lee (Gordon) Boydston, on February 7, 1948, in San Jose, California.

Butch was raised in Lindsay and was a graduate of the Lindsay High School. He moved away around 1970, but Lindsay was always home to him. He returned in 2010 and has been a resident ever since. He spent most of his occupational life in the trucking industry. He drove a truck for Wagoner Trucking and he dispatched for Hamm & Phillips at different periods in his life. He was also able to be the boss and run his own company, Boydston Oilfield Services.
