Leonard "Len" W. Burford was born in Lindsay, Oklahoma on October 6, 1935 to Earl Elmore and Faye (Webb) Burford. He passed from this earthly life on Thursday, February 14, 2013 in Norman, Oklahoma at the age of 77.

Len married Tujuana Sue Wayland on June 8, 1957, in Maysville, Oklahoma. They had three sons. In 1968, Len and his family moved from Lindsay, Oklahoma to Norman, Oklahoma. Len's career was in farming and manufacturing.

Len was a member of the First Baptist Church of Norman, Oklahoma and a member and past Master of the Moore Masonic Lodge #539.
