Loyd "Bryson" Beebe was born on April 10, 1951, in Anderson, South Carolina, to Loyd Matthew Beebe and Ruth (Taylor) Beebe. He passed from this life on August 12, 2025, at his residence in Lindsay, Oklahoma, at the age of 74.

At the age of nineteen, Bryson made the choice to join the United States Air Force, and it was there that he was trained to become a dedicated serviceman and skilled professional. He proudly served his country with honor as a K9 military police officer from 1970 to 1975. While in the Air Force, Bryson also cross-trained in Air Traffic Control. Following his military service he pursued a bachelor's degree from Clemson University, graduating in 1979.
