Lucile Merle Selzer Loman was born the eleventh child of twelve on March 15, 1922, to Edward and Freda Selzer in Bradley, Oklahoma at the farmhouse in Bradley. Lucile graduated from Bradley High School. She received her Bachelor's Degree of Education from the Oklahoma Women's College in Chickasha, Oklahoma and received her Master's Degree, with honors, from East Central University in Reading Education. She taught school at Bradley (during War II), Maysville, and Lindsay. Lucile retired after 29 years of teaching. She was a member of the United Methodist Church, UMW and Retired Teachers' Association. Lucile enjoyed playing cards, rock hunting and working in her flower beds and garden. She also loved the mountains.

Lucile married Lloyd M. Loman on May 16, 1943, and to this union three children were born; Loretta, Lynn and Mark. Mrs. Loman passed away September 9, 2014 in Lindsay, Oklahoma at the age of 92 years, 5 months and 24 days.
