



## Marcia Oleta Nichols Nunn

January 4, 1916 - March 20, 2012

Marcia Oleta (Nichols) Nunn, age 96, died Tuesday, March 20, 2012 at the Lindsay Manor Nursing Home. She was born on January 4, 1916 at Pauls Valley, Oklahoma, to Elmer Lester Nichols and Johnnie Lou Washington Nichols. The family soon moved to Burkburnett, Texas, where her father was the band director. Marcia started to school and graduated high school at Burkburnett High School. Her fondest memories were of the time she spent playing in her father's band. It was during this young period of her life that Marcia came to know the Lord and was baptized at the First Christian Church. She had a great love of music and was an accomplished pianist and was still playing until the last couple of years. Marcia was an artistic person, excelling in any endeavor that caught her interest. She was an excellent seamstress.

Marcia and Art Nunn were married on November 12, 1972 in Randlett, Oklahoma. After his retirement, they moved to Red River, New Mexico, where they spent over thirteen wonderful years in their cabin in the mountains. They were active in all the community activities at Red River, and Marcia was the pianist at the First Baptist Church in Questa, New Mexico. Health complications made it necessary for them to move back to Oklahoma, and they have lived in Lindsay, Oklahoma since 1996. Mrs. Nunn was a member of the First Baptist Church of Lindsay.
