Marilyn Kay Brooks was born on May 5, 1954 in Shattuck, Oklahoma to Alan Dean Owens and Mary Mae (Furgason) Owens. Marilyn married William “David” Brooks on January 3, 1976 at the Methodist Church in Buffalo, Oklahoma. They lived in Charleston, South Carolina while David was in the Navy; then, they moved to Laverne, Oklahoma for 18 years. They were blessed with two children, Kandi, born on June 13, 1978 and Justin Owen, born on September 17, 1982.

Marilyn and David moved with their family to Lindsay, Oklahoma on December 30, 1995. Marilyn was a mother, grandmother and a registered nurse. She obtained her Associate of Science Degree in Nursing from Dodge City Community College, graduating in 1991. She most recently worked as a Registered Nurse at Lindsay Manor Nursing Home in Lindsay, Oklahoma. Marilyn had also previously worked at Harper County Community Hospital, Norman Regional Hospital and Duncan Regional and Home Health. She was a member of the Nursing Association and the First Methodist Church. Marilyn’s favorite activities were traveling, woodworking, reading and cross stitch. But she especially found joy being with her family and grandchildren. She had fun looking at toys online with Kylee, playing computer games and researching Owens-Furgason family history.
