Marjorie Amner Paddack was born February 21, 1917 to John Henderson and Cora Lillian Hubbard near Amber, Oklahoma. She went to be with her Lord on February 21, 2010. She was the 15th of 16 children. The first 16 years of her life were spent in several homes near Amber and Fairview, Oklahoma. At age 16, the family moved to Alex, Oklahoma, where she was Valedictorian of her graduating class.

Marjorie married Lloyd Arlie Paddack on June 14, 1935 at Alex, Oklahoma. Lloyd was a farmer and then worked for Superior Oil Company. Lloyd and Marjorie lived in Oakland, California, as well as Alex, Dibble, Bradley, Chickasha, Elmore City, and Lindsay, Oklahoma. Marjorie was a wife, homemaker, and mother of four children. She left this life while living at Lindsay, OK, where she had lived for 58 years.

In the book, *Passing the Baton of Faith*, which Marjorie co-authored, she wrote, "At age 13, I went to my brothers' bedroom and knelt behind a curtain across one corner that made a triangular closet and repented of my sins and asked Jesus to save me." Marjorie was a charter member of the Missionary Baptist Church of Lindsay, where she was honored many times by her church for her dedicated service. She had a great passion for the souls of children and taught Sunday School and worked with children, as well as being church clerk for many years. She was a volunteer at the Lindsay Elementary

School Library with her daughter, Kay Gage, for many years, until she was 87 years old. In 2002, Marjorie received the Outstanding Basketball Fan Award from the Lindsay Booster Club.

Marjorie was preceded in death by her husband, Lloyd Arlie Paddack, and great grand daughter, Taylor Paige DeArman.
