Nelda G. Freeny of Alex, Oklahoma passed from this life on Wednesday, February 23rd, 2011 at Oklahoma Heart Hospital in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma at the age of 74. Nelda was born on February 7, 1937 in Duncan, Oklahoma to James Doolin Martin and Lena Estelle (Welch) Martin.
