Nina Mae Hale passed away on November 30, 2013 at Norman Regional Hospital in Norman, Oklahoma after a brief illness. The memorial service will be Friday, December 13, 2013 at two-thirty p.m. at the United Methodist Church, located at 411 W. Chickasaw in Lindsay, Oklahoma with Rev. Ron King officiating.

Nina was born October 25, 1931 in Great Bend, Kansas to Hazel and George Merten. She grew up in Great Bend and graduated from Great Bend High School. She met Kenneth Hale, who was working in the oil fields in Great Bend, and they were married on January 7, 1952. They raised two daughters and two sons. She was active in the home economist program sponsored by the county extension office. She loved to cook, bake, sew and quilt. Her family came first in her life. She was a devoted mother and grandmother. She was a Girl Scout leader and camp counselor. She was a supporter of the Argonne Rebels Drum and Bugle Corps. In 1972, the family moved to Lindsay, Oklahoma. Later her mother, Hazel Merten also moved to Lindsay and lived in Lindsay Place until her death in 2004. Nina worked for Dr. Long, optometrist, and later, for the American Exchange Bank from 1980 until retiring in 2002. She was a member of the Lindsay United Methodist Church and United Methodist Women.

Nina was preceded in death by her parents, husband, Kenneth, and her

brother, Donald.
