When David, her son, complained that she didn't make him anything, she and Deborah got together and made the ugliest pair of pants possible and made him wear them.

Nina would tell you that the favorite part of her life was her grandchildren, her great-grandchildren, and living in Colorado. It was always her and Elmer's dream to retire there. They built a cabin about fifty miles from Montrose, Colorado, and lived there for about a year, before deciding to move closer to medical facilities. They then moved to Howard, Colorado, and were about twenty miles from town. Once the grandchildren were born, she and Elmer moved to Duncan, Oklahoma, to be closer and visit more often.

Nina was preceded in death by her husband, Elmer Harris, her parents, Perry and Wilnor Farley, and her four brothers. She is survived by her two children, Deborah and David, her two grandchildren, Taylor and Abby, her two great-granddaughters, Charlotte and Sloane, and her three sisters.

Nina will be remembered for her sewing skills, her ability to pull a good joke, and to be on the receiving end of one too. We will all miss her.
