Obreta Vaun (Gregory) Green passed from this life December 2, 2009 at Mercy Hospital in Oklahoma City at the age of 77. She was born October 17, 1932 to Hoyt and Esther (Harris) Gregory in Lindsay, Oklahoma.

Obreta, or "Sis" as she was known, went to See Chapel and Pikes Peak grade schools. She attended Cox City her freshman year. The family moved to Lindsay her sophomore year, and she graduated from Lindsay High School. She attended Draughons Business School, and her first job was for Cargill Grain Company in Ft. Worth, Texas.

"Sis" was saved in 1946 at Pikes Peak and was baptized in the Cox City Baptist Church.

"Sis" married Robert Clarence "Bob" Green of Lindsay, Oklahoma and to this union three sons were born.

She retired from the Planned Parenthood and W.I.C. Department of Oklahoma County in 2005. Then, in 2006, she moved from her home of thirty-eight years in Midwest City to Yukon, Oklahoma to be near her son, Chet.

Obreta was preceded in death by her parents and her sister, Roena Plog of Nocomo Park, Oklahoma. Roena passed away on January 15, 2006.

Survivors are her three sons; Gregory Lynn Green and wife Chris of Ft. Worth, Texas, Drew Allen Green and wife Angel of Blanchard, Oklahoma and Chet Laray Green and wife Robin of Yukon, Oklahoma, two granddaughters; Brandi Green and Amber Morrison and husband Nathan, two grandsons; Barrett Green and Colin Chandler Green and a great-grandson, Christian. She is also survived by her brother, Jack Gregory and wife Evelyn of Midwest City, Oklahoma, her Aunt Susie and Uncle Hoot Goodno of Ponca City, Oklahoma and several nieces and nephews, cousins and friends. "Sis" left behind a special pal, her dog, Mr. Murphy.
