Oleda Flud passed away on Thursday, November 25th , 2010 at Select Specialty Hospital in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma at the age of 96. Oleda was born on August 3rd, 1914 in Purdy, Oklahoma to Charlie and Bertha Denson. She married James Willard Flud in 1932.

She was preceded in death by her husband, parents and one brother Glen
