



Orville Curtis Scaggs

December 17, 1918 - November 26, 2012

Orville Curtis Scaggs of Ardmore, Oklahoma, formerly of Lindsay, Oklahoma, passed from this life on Monday, November 26, 2012 at Mercy Hospital in Ardmore at the age of 93. Orville was born on December 17, 1918 near Cleveland, Oklahoma to William R. Scaggs and Tennie (Filbeck) Scaggs. He married Ruby Berniece Odom.

Orville owned his own oilfield service company, and he pioneered the invention of machinery for the pick-up and lay-down of pipe in drilling operations. He served his country in the U.S. Army and the U.S. Navy. Orville was a member of the First Baptist Church of Lindsay, Oklahoma. He loved fishing, playing dominoes and spending time with family.

Mr. Scaggs is survived by his daughter Rhonda Stinnett and husband Stan of Lindsay, OK and his grandchildren: Curtis Stinnett and wife Sarah of Ardmore, Oklahoma and Amy Stinnett of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma as well as his great-grandson, Tristan Stinnett of Ardmore, Oklahoma.

Orville was preceded in death by his wife, Ruby Berniece Scaggs who passed away January 10, 2001. He was also preceded in death by his parents, William R. Scaggs and Tennie Scaggs.

Funeral services for Mr. Scaggs are set for two o'clock p.m. on Wednesday,

November 28, 2012 at Green Hill Cemetery in Lindsay with Curtis Stinnett officiating and military honors by the American Legion Ball Smith Post 23. Services are under the direction of B.G.
