Ray Arnold Harjo was born on October 2, 1946 in Lindsay, Oklahoma to Raymond Harjo and Cecil Ann (Cacy) Harjo. He passed from this life at the age of 70 on May 10, 2017 in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.

Ray was the only child born to Raymond and Cecil. He graduated from the Oklahoma City Capitol Hill High School in 1964. He attended the Central State College where he graduated with a Bachelor of Arts in May of 1969.

Ray enlisted in the United States Army in April of 1970 during the Vietnam War and during his service he received the National Defense Service Medal. After he received an Honorable Discharge he began working for the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) where he fulfilled many different roles during his tenure there until his retirement.

Ray was a religious man and was a member of the Church of Christ. He was a member of the Seminole Nation. He was also a Shriner and a Mason; one of his most valued possession was his masonic ring.
