Raymond Dew was born on January 29th, 1932 in Lindsay, Oklahoma to William "Bill" S. Dew and Sadie "Lottie" (Tarwater) Dew. He was raised in Lindsay and was a life-long resident of Lindsay as well. He married Bonnie Frankenberg on February 3rd, 1951, and to that union were born two children, Nancy and Gary. Bonnie passed away on January 27th, 1986.
