Richard Dale Lindsey was born on January 23, 1930 in Elmore City, Oklahoma to Dale and Maud Lindsey. He served his country in the U.S. Air Force from 1948 to 1952. After serving in the military, he worked in the oilfield as a roughneck and also worked on his farm. He married Norma Lynch in 1981 and they made their home in Lindsay, Oklahoma, but he kept his farm and livestock in Elmore City. He loved feeding his cows and spending time with his twin sister, Gail, naming all 22 cows. He also loved spending time with his grandchildren, and loved watching baseball and going out to eat with family. After the passing of his beloved wife, Norma, in 2004, Richard moved back to the farm in Elmore City where he lived until his retirement. He was a member of the Methodist church in Elmore City. Richard passed from this life on Monday, July 14, 2014 at Lindsay Manor Nursing Home in Lindsay, Oklahoma at the age of 84.

Richard is survived by his children: Billie Baker and husband Doug of Edmond, Oklahoma, Sue Lynch of Bridge Creek, Oklahoma and Kim Webb of Lindsay, Oklahoma.
