Robert Cleveland "Bob" Roberson was born to Rufus C. Roberson and Alma Mae (Beasley) Roberson in Union Parish, Louisiana, on October 28, 1927. He completed his journey on this earth in Lindsay, Oklahoma on Monday, November 4, 2013 at the age of 86.

Bob married Helen LaVerne Hutson on April 17, 1949 in the First Baptist Church in Sterlington, Louisiana. He began his career with Columbia Carbon on March 24, 1947 at age 19, and retired from Cities Service/Oxy after 42 years, 7 months and 7 days of service. He never quit a job from the time he was 19 years old until his retirement at age 62. He served his co-workers as Union Steward. Bob served his country in the U.S. Air Force during the Korean Conflict. Bob and Helen moved to Lindsay from North Louisiana when they were transferred in 1963 along with several other families. They lived and raised their children in Lindsay. Bob loved hunting and fishing and was a handyman-craftsman who could build or repair most anything that did not have a computer. He was a member of the First Baptist Church of Lindsay and was recognized by the church for his service as a greeter.

Mr. Roberson is survived by a daughter and son-in-law, Ann and Lynn Rolan of Lindsay, Oklahoma; a son and daughter-in-law, Wayne and Donna Roberson of Lufkin, Texas, one brother, Dewey Roberson and wife Gay of Haile, Louisiana and one sister-in-law, Ruby Vinyard and husband Jay of

Choudrant, Louisiana. Bob also leaves behind his grandchildren: Kevin Rolen of Lindsay, Oklahoma and Matthew Roberson of Mesquite, Texas as well as his great-granddaughter, Zoe Claire Rolen and great-grandson, Tate Lynn Rolen of Lindsay, Oklahoma and his best friend and companion, Cricket.

Bob was preceded in death by his wife Helen Roberson, his parents, Rufus and Alma Roberson, one infant daughter, Patricia Ann Roberson, three brothers: Rufus C. Roberson Jr., J. B. Roberson and Donald Roberson and two sisters, Becky Turner and Peggy DeFee.
