Shirley Ann (Murphy) Troutman was born February 3, 1939, in McClain County, Oklahoma to John Casey Murphy and Louise Lee (Beasley) Murphy. She was a lifetime resident of Lindsay. She married Bobby Troutman on June 22, 1971. They were married thirteen years before Bobby's death on September 24, 1984.

Shirley was a homemaker.
