October 20, 1927 - October 25, 2011

Steve Hall was born in Bartlesville, OK on October 20, 1927. He had a younger sister, Joyce. After graduating, Steve entered the Air Force in February of 1945 and served in Japan until discharged in July of 1947. With the completion of his service, he went to Tulsa and for seven years, he worked for Nelson Electric Manufacturing Company as a sheet metal worker. Also, while in Tulsa, Steve operated a Phillips 66 service station for about six years.

In 1953, Steve married Martha Axson of Bartlesville. In November of 1960, they moved to Maysville along with their two sets of twins; Mark and Carol and Bill and Burt. Moving to Maysville, Steve and Martha purchased the Phillips Jobbership and Propane business. Steve was a member of the Maysville Kiwanis Club and served as president in 1963. They attended the First Baptist Church. Nearly four years later, Steve purchased the Phillips Jobbership business in Lindsay. In 1970, Steve and Martha built their new home in Lindsay, and moved their family to start their lives in the Lindsay community.

Steve was an excellent business man, devoted husband and loving father. The most important thing in his life was his family. They were always first and foremost to him. He always enjoyed his children, going to their ballgames, riding in the trucks or going to church. He was always proud of what his children did. He was also proud of his grandbabies and loved spending time

with them. His grandbabies meant the world to him. Steve enjoyed his work and traveling, but he will always be remembered as someone who had his priorities right, God and his family first.

Mr. Hall is survived by his daughter, Carol and husband Chris Tate, three sons; Mark Hall and wife Stacy, Burt Hall and wife Dawnisha and Bill Hall and his grandchildren; Steve James Hall, Caitlin Tate, Kurt Hall, Carson Tate, Allison Hall and Caleb Hall.

Steve was preceded in death by his wife, Martha Jane Hall who passed away February 2, 2002, his parents, Sherman Thomas Hall and Lennia Irene (Burton) Hall, his sister, Joyce Robertson and one grandson, Barrett Hall.

Funeral services for Mr. Hall are set for ten o'clock a.m. on Saturday, October 29, 2011 at the First Baptist Church in Lindsay, OK with Pastor Randy Allen officiating and Steve James Hall assisting.
