Susie "Sue" Imogene Ramsey passed from this life on Friday, February 22, 2013 at Lindsay Manor Nursing Home in Lindsay, Oklahoma at the age of 82. Sue was born to Arthur Campbell and Cora Campbell on January 6, 1931 in Lindsay, Oklahoma.
