Sylvan Yates "Buster" Sharp of Lindsay, Oklahoma passed from this life on Thursday, December 12, 2013 at the Lindsay Manor Nursing Home in Lindsay, OK at the age of 91. Sylvan was born on January 7, 1922 in Cooperton, Oklahoma to Hyrum Kirk Sharp and Lizzie Olive (Barker) Sharp. He married Helen Joyce Godwin on July 19, 1945 in Gregg County, Texas.
