



## Thomas Wendell Sinclair, Sr.

January 1, 1931 - July 22, 2007

Thomas Wendell Sinclair Sr. passed away on July 22, 2007 at Norman Regional Hospital. He was born on January 1, 1931 five miles SW of Lindsay, Oklahoma to Florence Mae and John Earl Sinclair. Thomas graduated eighth grade at See Chapel Grade School and went one year to Cox City High school before joining the Air force at 16 years of age. When he was released from the air force after serving for seven years, he went to California and worked on the railroad until 1996 and then moved back to Lindsay, Oklahoma. He was a conductor for the Santa Fe and Southern Pacific Railroads for 42 years. Thomas enjoyed traveling and riding motorcycles. He was not a member of any church but was of the Baptist belief.
