Tom Bob Sinclair, age 83, of Lindsay passed away Tuesday, February 18, 2003 at Integris Baptist Hospital in Oklahoma City. He was born to T. L. Sinclair and Maud McMurtry Sinclair on January 24, 1920 in Lindsay. Tom Bob was a life long resident of Lindsay and graduated from Lindsay High School. He worked for Rural Electric Cooperative and retired after 34 years of service. Tom Bob was a member of First Baptist Church where he was baptized in 1969. He was also a 50 year member of the Masonic Lodge, served on the school board, and was a honorary member of the Lindsay FFA.
