Tommy Gray was born on January 16, 1935 in Payne, Oklahoma to John Thomas Gray and Irna Belle (Hutcheson) Gray. He served his country as a member of the U. S. Army with a rank of Master Sergeant, serving as an M. P. stationed at Ft. Chaffee, Arkansas, near Ft. Smith. There, he met the love of his life, Lou Autry, where she worked as a waitress in her parents café. Tommy would say that there was something special about Lou. She was someone he wanted to meet. Tommy and Lou were married on August 9, 1962, in Poteau, Oklahoma. They made their home in Lindsay, Oklahoma with their daughter, Cheryl.

Tommy was a farmer and rancher as well as an auto parts dealer. He was interested in the auto parts business during and after high school and was a part owner in Trend Auto Supply in Lindsay for 38 years. He attended Calvary Baptist Church, was a member of the Masonic Lodge in Lindsay and served as an REC Board member. When he had spare time, he loved CB radios, fishing and watching westerns on TV, especially movies starring John Wayne. At the age of 79, Tommy passed from this life at home early Sunday morning, October 19, 2014, just ten days after the passing of his beloved wife, Lou. They are now reunited in Heaven.
