Troy A. Register was born on September 4, 1956, in Pauls Valley, Oklahoma, to Wanda Lee (Roberson) Harrell. He passed from this life on July 23, 2021, at the age of 64.

Troy married the love of his life, Cindy Ann (Cannon) Register, on October 30, 1981, in Gainesville, Texas.

Lindsay, Oklahoma, was the only home Troy knew during his lifetime. It was in Lindsay that his dad, Bud Harrell, taught him a strong work ethic that resonated with him in everything he did.
