January 30, 1922 - April 12, 2011

Virginia "Jinny" W. McMurtray of Lindsay, Oklahoma passed from this life on Tuesday, April 12th, 2011 at Norman Regional Hospital in Norman, Oklahoma at the age of 89. Jinny was born on January 30th, 1922 in Mechanicsburg, Pennsylvania to Daniel Walters and Minnie (Reed) Walters. She married Robert A.
