Wallace Levi Reneau, age 100, of Lindsay, Oklahoma passed away on Saturday, February 12, 2011 at his home in Lindsay, Oklahoma.

Wallace was born in Kiowa County, Oklahoma on January 3, 1911, to William Calvin Reneau and Margaret "Maggie" Catherine Pylant Reneau. He was the youngest of nine children; four brothers and four sisters.

Wallace was richly blessed with over 56 years of marriage to Beatrice Dennis Reneau who passed away June 10, 1999. Though they had no children of their own, they touched the hearts and lives of many in this community.

In his lifetime, Wallace worked his family farm; attended Business College in Oklahoma City; worked in banking; owned and operated a retail store in Lindsay; examined banks for the FDIC and finally, at the age of 82, retired from his own business as a bank auditor.

Wallace had a love for music and a gift for creating beautiful stained glass. In the last few years, Wallace established scholarships for Lindsay Graduates and wrote a study guide on the book of Revelation.

Most importantly is the way he lived his life. He taught us all by example, what it is to be a man of honor and integrity. He was honest, friendly and loving and he always had a smile.

Wallace is survived by his beloved nieces, nephews, great nieces and great nephews. He will be greatly missed by us all.
