Wayne Loafman passed from this life on Saturday, February 18, 2012 at Mercy Health Center in Oklahoma City, at the age of 86. Wayne was born on December 12, 1925 in Chickasha, Oklahoma to Perry Albin Loafman and Ethel Bell (Bradley) Loafman. He married Mary Marie Ragland on January 31, 1948 in Chickasha, Oklahoma.

Wayne and Marie were residents of Lindsay, Oklahoma from 1957 until 2010 when they moved to Edmond, Oklahoma. Wayne retired from Rural Electric Coop in Lindsay as an electrical engineer and manager. He was a member of the Church of Christ, and served on the Board of Directors at Mid-America Vo-Tech. Wayne coached little league baseball and enjoyed golfing and fishing. He loved sports in general, and as a graduate of Oklahoma State University, he loved watching the Cowboys. Most of all, Wayne loved his family and enjoyed spending time with them.
