William David Cheshier, age 49, of Wister, Oklahoma was born Wednesday, July 22, 1959 in the Pool Hospital at Lindsay, Oklahoma. He was the third son of the late Bascom Cheshier and Dorothy Cheshier Branch. David died March 8, 2009 as the result of a motorcycle accident in the Wister area.

David was a 1977 graduate of Lindsay High School and attended Oklahoma State Tech at Okmulgee.

As a youth, David enjoyed going to "Falls Creek" Baptist Conference Center near Davis every summer and there accepted Jesus Christ as his Saviour. He was a member of Erin Springs Baptist Church. He loved life, especially hunting, fishing and visiting with family and friends whether it was a campsite or around the table. He took pleasure in recounting events, telling stories or listening. David just enjoyed people. He had no children of his own but took pleasure in those of others, especially his nephews and nieces. David loved his dog, Cinnamon, and mourned her loss last summer. Motorcycles were a big part of his life. He and his friends rode at every opportunity. David was a man of integrity. As an employer and an employee, he was honest and fair. In all of the dealings and affairs of the business, he often gave more than what was expected.
