William G. "Bill" Clements, Jr. of Lindsay, Oklahoma passed from this life on Wednesday, June 1, 2011 in his home at the age of 62. Bill was born on November 4, 1948 in Pauls Valley, Oklahoma, to W.G. Clements and Fern Marie (Gosnell) Clements.

Bill graduated from Lindsay High School in 1967. He was an All-Conference football player and attended East Central University on a football scholarship where he was also named All-Conference. On November 25, 1970, Bill married Darla J. Compton in Oklahoma City. He graduated from E.C.U. in 1971.

After college, Bill went into business with his dad, W. G. Clements, in 1971. He later bought the business in 1979. Clements Insurance has been in business for 106 years, and it will continue to be run by Bill's wife, Darla and their children.

Bill was a Deacon and member of the First Christian Church of Lindsay, Oklahoma. He was also a member of the Kiwanis Club, Lindsay Athletic Booster Club, Lindsay Relay for Life, Lindsay B.P.O.E., Lindsay Hospital Board and the Mid-America Technology Center Board. Bill loved spending time with family and grandchildren. He also enjoyed traveling and tail-gating with friends at OU football games.

Mr. Clements is survived by his wife, Darla J. Clements of Lindsay, his children; Jason B. Clements and wife Sasha of Norman, Oklahoma, Bridget Furnish and husband Justin of Norman, Oklahoma, and Nick Clements and wife Jennifer of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, his brothers; Brent Clements and wife Donna of Norman, Oklahoma, and Ronnie Clements and wife Cathy of Frederick, Oklahoma, and his sister, Martha Eaves of Midwest City, Oklahoma. Bill also leaves behind his grandchildren; Logan Tate Furnish, Londyn Michelle Furnish, Will Hayden Clements, Reese Allison Clements, Lawson Heath Clements and a new baby Clements to arrive in November.

Mr. Clements was preceded in death by his parents W.G. Clements and Fern M. Clements and one brother, Richard B. Clements.

Funeral services for Mr. Clements are set for ten o'clock a.m. on Saturday, June 4th, 2011 at the Lindsay High School Gymnasium in Lindsay, Oklahoma with Rev. George Lupton officiating with a eulogy by Bill's son, Nick Clements. Interment will follow at Green Hill Cemetery in Lindsay, Oklahoma.
