William "Bill" J. Gray passed away on May 13, 2006 in Little Rock, Arkansas at the age of 65. Bill was born in Mena, Arkansas on September 15, 1940 to Oscar and Lily Malone Gray. Bill followed the family tradition of the Gray boys and entered into the U. S. Navy in 1963. He was proud to be in the Navy and took great pride that his brothers were able to serve also.
