March 11, 1954 - February 2, 2008

William Paul "Bronc" Jackson of Lindsay, OK died on February 2, 2008. Bronc was born to Paula and Chell Jackson in Purcell, OK on March 11, 1954. He graduated from Duncan High School, and later attended Oklahoma State University where he was a member of Delta Chi Fraternity. He graduated from OSU with a doctorate in Veterinary Medicine in 1981. He started his family with his wife Colleen and opened Jackson Animal Clinic in Lindsay, OK. The success of the clinic led to his purchase of Arbuckle Veterinary Clinic in Sulphur, OK in 2004.

Bronc was an active member in the United Methodist Church of Lindsay, OK. Along with his commitment to his church, he was committed to his community. He served as President of the Lindsay Chamber of Commerce and was on the Board of Education for Lindsay Public Schools for the past 13 years. Bronc also served his community as a volunteer fireman. He became a member of the Masonic Lodge at the age of 21 and was an active member of the Royal Order of Jesters. Bronc envisioned and organized the building of Griffith Sports Complex in Lindsay and was instrumental in building the Lindsay Skate Park.

Bronc's love for his community was surpassed by his love for his family, especially his children Sean and Kelsey Jackson. Bronc was involved in all aspects of his family's life, from coaching Little League to camping, snow

skiing, going to the lake, and receiving his second degree black belt alongside his son. He was a wonderful father and his family was his pride and joy.

Bronc is survived by his two children, Sean Jackson of Tulsa, OK and Kelsey Jackson of Stillwater, OK his mother Paula Jackson of Nocona, Texas, sister Mitchell Harper and husband Gary of Katy, TX , Colleen Jackson of Tulsa, OK and numerous nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his father Chell Jackson, grandparents Bill and Nell Jackson and Lela and Paul Cochran.
