On Thursday August 4th, 2011, Willie Franklin departed this life. She was 89 years old. Willie loved her family. She had a hand in raising each of her grandchildren and great-grandchildren. Willie enjoyed spending time with them. It didn't matter what they were doing, she was always right there to help. Willie bragged on each and every one of them to anyone who would listen.

Down through the years, the family would tease Willie because she could work circles around all of us. She was a very strong lady, managing rental properties and raising a beautiful garden. It didn't matter what kind of dead plant you took her, she could revive it. Even after she had her stroke, Willie continued to talk about working in the dirt.
