Zid Russell, a long-time resident of Lindsay, Oklahoma, passed away on June 3, 2006 in Lancaster, California. She was born on February 25, 1910, to William and Alice Smith. Zid moved to Lancaster, California in May 2005, to be closer to her daughters. In 1972 she retired from Oklahoma's Central State Hospital in Norman, Oklahoma, which is now known as Griffin Psychiatric Hospital. She was known as a true matriarch and a wonderful and religious woman who was a caregiver, a teacher, a medical researcher, wife, mother and great grandmother.
